Alabama Acteens™ Challenge Team is made up of Acteens™ who live Colossians 3 from *The Message*.

“So if you’re serious about living this new resurrection life with Christ, act like it. Pursue the things over which Christ presides. Don’t shuffle along, eyes to the ground, absorbed with things right in front of you. Look up, and be alert to what is going on around Christ—that’s where the action is.” Colossians 3, The Message

Alabama Acteens™ Challenge Team members will exemplify Christ as they represent Alabama Acteens for our state by:

1. Participating in the planning and leading of Complete according to their individual gifts. Team members will be required to attend Complete and must provide their own transportation; housing and food expenses will be provided by Alabama WMU.
2. Sharing their testimony verbally and/or in written form.
3. Writing an article for “Panorama”, the Alabama WMU newsletter.
4. Helping to strengthen and encourage Acteens groups by visiting and sharing with them personal experiences from their Christian walk and life as an Acteen. Team members must be willing to visit at least three Acteens groups or associational events as their schedule allows.
5. Representing Alabama Acteens/WMU at other events as requested and as schedule will allow.

When representing Alabama Acteens in public, team members will be asked to dress in a uniform fashion wearing black pants and the challenge team shirt. Alabama WMU® will provide the Acteens™ Challenge team shirt with logo.

Alabama Acteens Advisors will be asked to support their Alabama Acteen Challenge Team member by:

1. Providing her with Christ like love, support and encouragement.
2. Assisting her in setting up speaking engagements.
3. Helping her prepare for speaking engagements and/or church/association events.
All Challenge Team members will be eligible for a missions involvement scholarship for up to \$150.00 during their year of service.

To Apply, Acteens:

1. Must be entering the tenth grade or above, or be 15 years old by September 1st.
2. Must be an active member of a local Acteens™ organization and an active member of a Southern Baptist Church.
3. Must complete application and write paragraphs describing (please type paragraphs):
 - A) “How I Became A Christian and How I Have Grown as a Christian During the Past Year”
 - B) “Why Acteens™ is Important to Me”
 - C) “Why I Want to Serve on the Alabama Acteens™ Challenge Team.”
 - D) “An idea for a conference to be offered at Complete.”
4. Must agree to serve from September 1st to August 31st _____. Team members may participate in Complete programming as well as other Acteens™ promotion and/or state sponsored events.
5. **Must have application to Alabama WMU no later than May 3rd.**
Applications must include **most recent and clearest passport size photo**, parent’s signature, Acteens Advisor/Director’s signature, and requested paragraphs.

Note: Only fully completed applications will be considered.

* NOTE: Applicants are not required to be participating in MissionsQuest™; however, special consideration will be given to those who are.

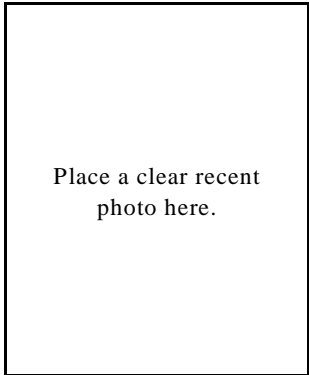
