

**Mission New Orleans Prayerwalking Trip**  
**April 24-26, 2008**  
Answers to Frequently Asked Questions

**How much will it cost?**

Registration is \$50 and includes Thursday and Friday night's lodging, meals on Friday and through Saturday lunch, supplemental trip insurance and a t-shirt. You are responsible for meals as you travel (including Thursday supper) and for lunch on Friday. You will also have costs from travel, depending on your travel arrangements.

**What is the deadline for registering?**

Registration deadline is April 1, 2008. This will allow our missionary contact to make prayerwalking plans for the number registering and for Oak Park Baptist to plan meals.

**Who can come?**

The trip is open to all adults (men and women).

**Can I come for just part of the time?**

**Are we traveling as a group?**

Alabama WMU is not planning group transportation. However, you can check with others in your area to arrange transportation, possibly through your church or association.

**Where will we stay?**

Our lodging is at Oak Park Baptist Church. Cots will be available for sleeping. There is some room for blow up mattresses (twin size only). Bathrooms will be shared and showers are available. There will be separate accommodations for males and females. The address for the church is 1110 Kabel Dr., New Orleans, LA 70131. The church has room for 300 people.

**How can I get directions to New Orleans?**

You can get directions at [www.mapquest.com](http://www.mapquest.com). Directions to the church will also be sent with your confirmation after you register.

**What about meals?**

Oak Park will be preparing our meals on Friday and Saturday morning. We will eat Friday and Saturday breakfasts and Friday supper at the church. Friday lunch is on your own. Saturday lunch will be provided at our debriefing.

**How far will we walk?**

None of our plans call for long distances or strenuous walking. You can pray from a vehicle or from a stationary position.
