Dear Missions Leader:

Gratitude is the word that comes to mind when I think of you and the work you accomplish through your church. I know that it not only takes a heart committed to telling the mission story, but a person who is dedicated to prepare and give of their time to share that story with preschoolers, children, teenagers and/or adults. Whatever group God has called you to serve, thank you!

I am writing today to ask you to help with an important project. Alabama WMU has the privilege of owning a camp dedicated to missions. The name of this camp is WorldSong Missions Place and it sits at the base of Bald Mountain in Cook Springs, Alabama.

WorldSong provides a place where campers can get alone with God and hear his voice without the distractions of everyday life. In fact, this summer more than thirteen hundred girls and boys participated in summer missions camps and 129 of those campers heard God speak to them in a very specific way, either to salvation, rededication or a call to mission service.

Seven years ago Alabama WMU stepped out on faith and engaged in a God-sized building and renovation project at WorldSong. At the end of this project we had two beautiful new lodges, air conditioning in all cabins, brand-new bunk beds and some much needed repairs!

The results! Since 1999 when this project was completed the number of campers that utilize the facilities at WorldSong has more than doubled. With the addition of air conditioning and new beds we saw an immediate change in the attitudes of our summer campers. This transformation made it easier for the cabin leaders and missionaries to hold the attention of the campers resulting in more than eleven hundred decisions in the past seven years. This equates to girls serving around the world in missions.

There is no way to put a price tag on a ministry that touches the lives of young girls so deeply! However, we find ourselves at a point of need. You have been faithful in giving and because of this we have been able to pay on our note yearly; however, it is time to pay off the debt. Next year the note is due and Alabama WMU believes it is time to pay off this note and look toward expansion for the future.

Enclosed you will find a simple plan about giving that will help us meet this God-sized challenge. Would you please consider leading your mission group to be a part of this exciting opportunity? How “*Rekindle*” Works

§ **Each Association enlists 100 groups of 10 people**

Groups can be: Women on Mission, Acteens, Youth on Mission, GAs, CiAs, Mission Friends, family, friends, etc.

§ **Each person in the group of 10 is asked to commit \$20 a year**

\$10 in the Fall and \$10 in the Spring to equal a total of \$200 given per group (keep in mind an individual may donate \$200 and be considered a group). Your group may decide to donate the total of \$200 at one time.

§ **Groups may give more than the \$200 requested.**

Giving like this will help to retire the note that is due next June and help WorldSong begin to look toward expansion.
